

## Chapter 88

### BUILDINGS, NUMBERING OF

#### GENERAL REFERENCES

#### § 88-1. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

**BUILDING** — Any structure used or intended to be used as a dwelling or place of business or industry, but shall not include any public building or structure built as a place of worship, or any accessory building located upon a lot where there is also a main building.

#### § 88-2. Designation and numbering according to map.

All existing buildings are hereby designated and numbered according to the plan or map attached hereto and made a part hereof, and the Borough Secretary is directed to advise the owner of every lot upon which a building is located upon request of the number assigned to such building.

#### § 88-3. Streets named according to map.

The various streets, roads, avenues, public ways now existing in the Borough of Linesville and heretofore opened or laid out are hereby named and designated by the names appearing on said map, attached to this chapter and made a part hereof.

#### § 88-4. Number requirements. <sup>1</sup>

Numbers as assigned to each building in the Borough according to the provisions of this chapter shall be as specified in the International Property Maintenance Code as administered

by Chapter 178, Property Maintenance. The property owners shall reaffix or renew all numbers that shall not continue to conform to the requirements.

**§ 88-5. Time frame for compliance.**

The owner of each building in the Borough of Linesville shall within 60 days after the passage of this chapter, provide, affix and set up a number upon such owner's building in accordance with this chapter, and each and every property owner not so affixing a number to said property owner's building within said 60 days shall be notified in writing by the Borough Secretary to comply with this chapter within 30 days after receipt of said written notice, and every property owner who shall disregard or fail to comply with such notice within the time limits stated shall be guilty of a violation of this chapter.

**§ 88-6. Application to Secretary for official number.**

Whenever a building shall hereafter be erected in the Borough, the owner thereof shall forthwith apply to the Borough Secretary for the official number thereof. The number shall be assigned by the Borough Secretary from the vacant numbers existing on said map attached hereto and made a part thereof and in conformity with said map and this chapter and the numbers if existing buildings, and shall, within 30 days after being assigned to such building, be affixed by the owner thereof in the manner required by this chapter in the case of existing buildings and shall thereafter be maintained as hereby required for the numbers of existing buildings.

**§ 88-7. Violations and penalties. <sup>2</sup>**

Any person who shall violate the provisions of this chapter shall, in a summary proceeding before a Magisterial District Judge and upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$600, plus costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to undergo imprisonment for not more than 30 days.
